

**Town of Taylor Minutes of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen**  
**Regular Monthly Meeting on January 1, 2013**

Be it remembered that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Taylor, Mississippi, met in a Regular Meeting at the Town Hall on this the first Tuesday, the first day of January, 2013, at 7:00 p.m., with the following officers and members present, constituting a legal quorum to-wit:

Mayor Jim Hamilton; Alderman Betty Kisner; Alderman Courtney Covington-Nichols; Alderman Tim Bridges; Alderman Lyn Roberts; and Clerk Richard Williams.

Alderman Pete Brummett was absent.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Hamilton, and the following business was had and done to-wit:

**Adopt Agenda:** Alderman Covington-Nichols made a motion to adopt the meeting agenda; the motion was duly seconded by Alderman Bridges and passed unanimously.

**Approve December 4, 2012, Meeting Minutes:** Upon motion of Alderman Kisner, seconded by Alderman Bridges, and passed unanimously, it was ordered that the minutes for the December 4, 2012, meeting be approved.

**Approve January 1, 2013, Claims Docket:** Upon a motion made by Alderman Bridges, duly seconded by Alderman Covington-Nichols and passed unanimously, it was ordered that the Docket of Claims dated January 1, 2013, be approved.

**Lafayette County Road Report:** Clerk Williams reported that Lafayette County did not submit a Road Report for the month.

**Town Clerk's Report:** Clerk Williams presented the Elections Calendar for the 2013 Municipal Elections.

Mayor Hamilton asked about the qualifying forms and petitions for candidates. Clerk Williams said they are on the Secretary of State website and that he would print them and make them available.

Clerk Williams reported that the annual Audit Exemption Request had been accepted by the state.

**Mayor's Report:** Mayor Hamilton said that Plein Air is going to proceed with application for resort status, but has not completed the process.

Mayor Hamilton said that the Plein Air road paving letter of credit expiration date has passed. He has not heard from the county, Mr. McCool or the town attorney concerning the situation. He will request that the town attorney send a letter to Plein Air stating that the Town of Taylor will not accept Plein Air's streets as town streets without an engineer's report that the streets meet county standards upon completion.

The mayor reported that the job description and training requirements for the Town Marshal were not ready yet.
