

**Town of Taylor Minutes of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen
Swearing In on July 2, 2013**

Be it remembered that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Taylor, Mississippi, met in a Called Meeting for Swearing In at the Town Hall on this the first Tuesday, the second day of July, 2013, at 6:45 p.m., with the following officers and members present, constituting a legal quorum to-wit:

Alderman Courtney Covington-Nichols was absent

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Hamilton, and the following business was had and done to-wit:

Adopt Agenda: Alderman Bridges made a motion to adopt the meeting agenda; the motion was duly seconded by Alderman Willingham and passed unanimously.

Announce the Election of the New Mayor and Board of Aldermen: Clerk Williams announced that the Town of Taylor held a General Municipal Election on June 4, 2013 and that the results were as follows:

Five Aldermen At Large: TIM BRIDGES; DOROTHY (BETTY) KISNER; ELLEN B. MEACHAM; COURTNEY COVINGTON NICHOLS; JIMMIE WILLINGHAM

Administer the Oath of Office to the New Mayor and Board of Aldermen: Mayor Hamilton directed the Town Clerk to administer the Oath of Office to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, swearing them into office and turning control of the Town of Taylor to them. Clerk Williams administered the oath of office and swore in the new Mayor and Board of Aldermen.
