

Town of Taylor Minutes of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen
Regular Monthly Meeting on April 1, 2014

Be it remembered that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Taylor, Mississippi, met in a Regular Meeting at the Town Hall on this the first Tuesday, the first day of April, 2014, at 7:00 p.m., with the following officers and members present, constituting a legal quorum to-wit:

Aldermen: Tim Bridges (Mayor Pro Tempore); Betty Kisner; Courtney Covington-Nichols; Jimmie Willingham; and Clerk Richard Williams.

Mayor Jim Hamilton and Alderman Ellen Meacham were absent.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro Tempore Bridges, and the following business was had and done to-wit:

Adopt Agenda: Alderman Kisner moved to adopt the meeting agenda; the motion was duly seconded by Alderman Willingham and passed unanimously.

Approve Prior Meeting Minutes: Alderman Willingham moved that the minutes for the March 4, 2014, meeting be approved; the motion was seconded by Alderman Kisner, and passed unanimously.

Approve Current Claims Docket: Alderman Covington-Nichols moved to approve the Docket of Claims dated April 1, 2014; the motion was duly seconded by Alderman Willingham and passed unanimously.

Town Clerk's Report:

Lafayette County Road Report: Clerk Williams reported that he had received a County Road Report for February, 2014 showing: CR 323 Clean out ditches; CR 303 Clean out ditches; CR 321 Replace 2 culverts; CR 352 Replace culvert.

He also received a report for March, 2014 showing no activity for the month, but received a follow up email indicating: CR 337 Ditching

Planning Commission Report: An application for a special event scheduled for April 12th was turned down due to insufficient time for notice prior to a March meeting of the planning commission. Risa Darby also asked in a phone conversation if they need a permit for a private benefit at Plein Air for a family at Regents School. None of the board members felt like a permit should be required for the described benefit.

Voter ID Information: The Secretary of State's representative brought posters and flyers by town hall announcing the June 3, 2014 beginning of the State of Mississippi requirement for picture voter identification at elections.
