

**NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING  
ON THE PROPOSED BUDGET AND PROPOSED TAX LEVIES  
FOR THE UPCOMING FISCAL YEAR  
FOR THE TOWN OF TAYLOR, MISSISSIPPI**

The Town of Taylor will hold a public hearing on its proposed budget and proposed tax levies for fiscal year 2018 on Thursday, August 31, 2017 at 7:00 PM at Taylor Town Hall, 12 Main Street, Taylor, MS.

The Town of Taylor is now operating with projected total budget revenue of \$77,206.26. Twenty percent (20%) or \$15,616.01 of such revenue is obtained through ad valorem taxes. For the next fiscal year, the proposed budget has total projected revenue of \$89,741.00. Of that amount, seventeen and four tenths percent (17.4%) or \$15,616.00, is proposed to be financed through a total ad valorem tax levy.

The decision to not increase the ad valorem tax millage rate for fiscal year 2018 above the current fiscal year's ad valorem tax millage rate means you will not pay more in ad valorem taxes on your home, automobile tag, utilities, business fixtures and equipment and rental real property, unless the assessed value of your property has increased for fiscal year 2018.

Any citizen of the Town of Taylor is invited to attend this public hearing on the proposed budget and tax levies for fiscal year 2018 and will be allowed to speak for a reasonable amount of time and offer tangible evidence before any vote is taken.

Accommodations will be made for persons with disabilities. For any additional information, contact the Taylor Town Hall during normal business hours.
