

PLEIN AIR STREET LIGHTS RESOLUTION

A Resolution by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Taylor, Mississippi to pay to the Plein Air Home Owners Association a partial reimbursement of the monthly cost of the street lights within the Plein Air Neighborhood.

WHEREAS, The Town of Taylor currently pays the cost of the street lights in all areas of the town, except the Plein Air Neighborhood, directly to Northeast Mississippi Electric Power Association at the average rate of nine dollars (\$9.00) per street light: and

WHEREAS, The Plein Air Home Owners Association pays Northeast Mississippi Electric Power Association directly for the cost of the street lights with the Plein Air Neighborhood: and

WHEREAS, the style of street lights used within the Plein Air Neighborhood are billed by Northeast Mississippi Electric Power Association at a much higher rate than the nine dollars (\$9.00) average paid by the Town of Taylor.

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Taylor, Mississippi that:

The Town of Taylor shall reimburse the Plein Air Home Owners Association for the street lights within the Plein Air Neighborhood on a monthly basis at the rate of nine dollars (\$9.00) per street light. Said reimbursement shall be paid by upon receipt of an invoice from the Home Owners Association and in the same manner as all other claims are paid by the Town. Said invoice shall indicate the time period of the billing and the number of lights billed to the Home Owners Association for that time period. The invoice shall be submitted to the town clerk no later than the close of business on Wednesday preceding the First Tuesday of each month. The first invoice shall be for the billing period that ends in the month of September 2016.

The Clerk of this Board be and is hereby ordered to print this resolution and have a copy of this resolution posted in its entirety in three public locations within the municipality, including at the Town Hall, within ten days after this date.

This resolution shall be in full force and effect after its passage.
