RESOLUTION OF INTENT  
RESOLUTION TO PARTICIPATE NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE COMMUNITY RATING  
SYSTEM FOR TAYLOR, MISSISSIPPI**

**WHEREAS**, certain areas of Taylor, Mississippi are subject to periodic flooding, or flood-related erosion, causing serious damages to properties within these areas; and

**WHEREAS**, relief is available in the form of federally subsidized flood insurance as authorized by the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968; and

**WHEREAS**, the National Flood Insurance Program offers communities the opportunity to participate in their Community Rating System which provides discounts to citizens on their National Flood Insurance premiums; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent of this Board to comply with the National Flood Insurance Community Rating System standards in order to make available to the citizens of Taylor, Mississippi the greatest amount of discounts allowable; and

**WHEREAS**, this body has the legal authority to participate in the National Flood Insurance Community Rating System;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that this Board hereby:

Applies to the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency to initiate the appropriate activities and review in pursuit of the benefits of the National Flood Insurance Program Community Rating System; and

Agrees to take such other official action, as may be reasonable necessary to carry out the objectives of the program.
