

**NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING  
ON THE PROPOSED BUDGET AND PROPOSED TAX LEVIES  
FOR THE UPCOMING FISCAL YEAR  
FOR THE TOWN OF TAYLOR, MISSISSIPPI**

The Town of Taylor will hold a public hearing on its proposed budget and proposed tax levies for fiscal year 2020 on Tuesday, September 1st, 2020 at 6:30 PM at Taylor Town Hall, 12 Main Street, Taylor, MS.

The Town of Taylor is now operating with projected total budget revenue of \$138,705.60 (23.2%) or \$32,179.69 of such revenue is obtained through ad valorem taxes. For the next fiscal year, the proposed budget has total projected revenue of \$109,143.60. Of that amount, (22.9%) or \$24,993.88 is proposed to be financed through a total ad valorem tax levy.

The decision to not increase the ad valorem tax millage rate for fiscal year 2021 above the current fiscal year's ad valorem tax millage rate of nine (9) mills means you will not pay more in ad valorem taxes on your home, automobile tag, utilities, business fixtures and equipment and rental real property, unless the assessed value of your property has increased for fiscal year 2021.

Any citizen of the Town of Taylor is invited to attend this public hearing on the proposed budget and tax levies for fiscal year 2021 and will be allowed to speak for a reasonable amount of time and offer tangible evidence before any vote is taken.

Accommodations will be made for persons with disabilities. For any additional information, contact the Taylor Town Hall during normal business hours.
