

**Town of Taylor Minutes of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen**  
**Regular Monthly Meeting on December 1, 2020**

1. Call to order.

The meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Taylor, Mississippi, was called to order by Mayor Hardy at 7:00 pm on Tuesday, the first day of December, 2020, with the following officers and members present, constituting a legal quorum to-wit:

2. Adopt the agenda for the meeting

It was moved by Alderman Bridges, seconded by Alderman Willingham to adopt the agenda for the meeting. All the aldermen present voting aye, Mayor Hardy declared the motion carried.

3. Approve Prior Meeting Minutes

It was moved by Alderman Edwards, seconded by Alderman Willingham to approve the minutes for the November 3, 2020 regular meeting. All the Aldermen present voting aye, Mayor Hardy declared the motion carried.

4. Approve Current Claims Docket

Mayor Hardy presented the current Claims Docket. It was moved by Alderman Willingham, seconded by Alderman Bridges that the current Claims Docket be paid. All the Aldermen present voting aye, Mayor Hardy declared the motion carried.

5. Town Clerk's Report

Clerk Conrad then reported that there was no report from the Lafayette County Road Department. Mayor Hardy stated that she had spoken with Ashley at the Lafayette County Road Department and Ashley has agreed to send us a report at least each quarter.

Town Clerk Conrad reported that there had been one Certificate of Occupancy issued during the past month and one Building Permit for Lot 68 of Plein Air.

6. Old Business.

Mayor Hardy stated that we had failed to do an evaluation on Scott Allen as Building Official and Inspector last month, but she believed that he was doing a good job and would like for him to continue in the capacity he was serving in, and that he had agreed

to do so. It was moved by Alderman Bridges, seconded by Alderman Willingham that Mr. Allan stay in the position of Building Official/Inspector. All the Aldermen present voting aye, Mayor Hardy declared the motion carried.

7. New Business.

Mayor Hardy stated that she had spoken to Mr. Scott Allan regarding the International Code and that Mr. Allan stated that we need to update our building codes and adopt the 2018 code. It was moved by Alderman Edwards, seconded by Alderman Willingham that the 2018 ICC be adopted. All the Aldermen present voting aye, Mayor Hardy declared the motion carried.

8. Mayor's Report.

Mayor Hardy stated that we had sent out to the businesses in Taylor that we would be following the mask mandate that was issued by the Governor of Mississippi.

Mayor Hardy then stated that she had bought some decorations for Town Hall because we had decided not to host an Open House this year, due to Covid-19.

Mayor Hardy then stated that she had spoken with Alderman Meacham and that Alderman Meacham had been in contact with our attorney to get advice on working the letter regarding the transfer of our basketball goals.




