

The Town of Taylor Minutes of the Taylor Planning Commission September 15, 2020

The Planning Commission of the Town of Taylor, Mississippi, met at the Town Hall for a called meeting on the 15th day of September, 2020, at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present: Planning Administrator Scott Allan; Commissioners Sue Cook; Elizabeth Dollarhide; Jared Spears; Anndy Veazy; Clerk Cindy Conrad; Citizen Lyn Roberts; and Mayor Christy Hardy.

Commissioner Cindy Hale – absent

The meeting was then called to Order by Vice-Chairman Veazey.

Adoption of the Agenda: Commissioner Veazey moved to adopt the meeting agenda; motion was seconded by Commissioner Cook and passed unanimously.

Adoption of the Minutes from the Previous Meetings: Commissioner Veazey moved to adopt the meeting minutes from June 30, 2020; motion was seconded by Commissioner Cook and passed unanimously.

Old Business: Clerk Conrad stated that the only old business would be that of the remodeling fees schedule. Planning Administrator Allan stated that he was still in the process of getting the schedule done with the definitions and would present to the Commission and Board of Alderman at a later date.

New Business: Mayor Christy Hardy administered the Oath and Swearing in of new Planning Commissioner Elizabeth Dollarhide.

Administrator's Report: Planning Administrator Allan stated again that he is working on the permit fee and schedules for the Town of Taylor for remodels, renovations or repairs and would be presenting that at a later date.
