Tax Levy on September 14, 2021**



Mayor Christy Hardy, Aldermen Shawn Edwards, Alderman Lyn Roberts, and Clerk Cindy Conrad.



TAX LEVY RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION FIXING AD VALOREM TAX LEVY ON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY FOR TAXES FOR THE TOWN OF TAYLOR, MISSISSIPPI, FOR THE YEAR 2021-2022

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE
TOWN OF TAYLOR, MISSISSIPPI:**

SECTION 1: For the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021, there shall be and there is hereby levied on all taxable property, real and personal, within the corporate limits of the Town of Taylor, Mississippi, for ad valorem taxes for municipal purposes, the following levy to be collected upon each dollar of assessed value as shown upon the real and personal ad valorem assessment rolls of said Town of Taylor, Mississippi, as to such property within the corporate limits, to-wit:

For general purposes and for general improvements: Nine (9) mills

SECTION 2: That the Tax Collector of Lafayette County, Mississippi, be and hereby is authorized and directed to collect said taxes for the Town of Taylor, Mississippi.


SECTION 3: The Clerk of this Board be and is hereby ordered to print this resolution and have a copy of this resolution posted in its entirety in three public locations within the municipality, including at the Town Hall, within ten days after this date, and to certify a copy of this resolution to the Tax Collector of Lafayette County, Mississippi, and to the State Tax Commission, as required by section 21-33-47, Mississippi State Code of 1972, Annotated.


SECTION 4: This resolution shall be in full force and effect after its passage.
